Show Rules

Make all checks payable to OPHC. Checks will be deposited promptly. NO POST DATED CHECKS. There will be a \$50 fee assessed for EACH time a check is returned by the bank. Credit cards have 3.75% convenience fee.

1. An entry in the Oregon Paint Horse Club, Painted N Sterling Fall Classic, is considered an entry under ALL judges.
2. Exhibitor Responsibility: SC-160.E-Exhibitors are responsible for being knowledgeable of and following the current rules, completing entry forms legibly and accurately, reporting to the gate promptly and being considerate of other exhibitors and show management. Additionally, exhibitors, owners and trainers are responsible to be knowledgeable of Rule SC-085 Drugs and Medications, forbidden, permitted & conditionally permitted substances. Conditionally permitted substances require a completed medication report be filed with show office. Inhumane treatment of animals on the grounds will not be tolerated. Rule SC-075. Proper action WILL be taken.
3. The Show Secretary or Office Staff MUST inspect the registration papers (or copies of) on each horse entered (except current year foals). Entries shall be made in the name of the recorded owners Rule SC 160.C. Geldings are not allowed to show with stallion papers Rule SC 160.I.3.
4. Leased Horses – the show secretary or office staff MUST inspect the APHA show lease certificate according to rules AM-020.A.1.F & YP-015.A.2.F.
5. To enter Amateur or Novice Amateur classes, you MUST present a current year APHA Amateur or Novice Amateur card, and own your horse according to Rule AM-015, AM-210, and AM-300.C.
6. Novice Youth MUST present a current Novice Youth Card from APHA in order to enter any Novice Youth Class, Rule YP-210. Additionally, Novice Youth may cross enter into the age appropriate Youth Class. Youth must present an AjPHA membership card in order to enter any youth classes (exception being Leadline and Walk/Trot) Rule YP-005.A.5
7. All Exhibitors AND Owners must present a current APHA membership card. Rule SC-160.A. The condition of submitting entries or the first entry into the show ring of a horse or exhibitor shall be deemed as acceptance of the APHA Official Rule Book and the Oregon Paint Horse Club general rules.
8. The final right to settle all questions or disputes arising incidentally to the Oregon Paint Horse Club – Painted N Sterling Spring Classic is reserved to the Show Management. All exhibitors, owners, and trainers, as condition of admission, give unqualified consent to such methods of settlement and agree in advance to be bound thereby.
9. Individual class entry registration will close TWO (2) classes prior to entry of that class.
10. Show management may combine or split classes according to APHA rules SC 185.G, AM 080.B, and YP 075.B.
11. Anyone withdrawing (scratching) from a class after entering shall forfeit their entry fee in accordance with Rule SC-185.A.
12. Exhibitors/Owners competing for Oregon Paint Horse Club – Painted N Sterling Fall Classic, are responsible for entering the correct classes to qualify for all awards. Award qualifying class lists will be available at the show.
13. No refund on stall(s) without Vet/Doctor note no further than one week after the show.
14. One Horse/One Rider combination to apply to all Youth & Amateur High Points.
15. Halter is required for High Point eligibility
16. Ties for High Points will be broken using the following:
 1. The Horse that earns the most firsts.
 2. The horse that places the most times.
 3. The flip of a coin.
17. High Point Awards will not be given out or available until one (1) hour after the last qualifying class. Awards MUST be picked up by the end of the show or be forfeited, unless arrangements are made to deliver awards.
18. NO DOGS ALLOWED IN THE ARENAS.
19. **NO CROSS TYING IN THE AISLE WAY. All cross tying must be done in a stall.**
20. **All bedding must be purchased from show management. No outside bedding allowed per Linn County Fair and Expo Center.**
21. **NWPHC= Northwest Paint Horse Championship (*)**

Beginner Class Rules:

- Rider may not have won more than 10 points in any Breed approved competition as of the date of the show weekend in the class entered. Once an exhibitor wins a buckle in a beginning class, are no longer eligible for that class.
- A belt buckle will be awarded to the winner in all Beginning classes.
- Year-End Awards will not be offered for any of the Beginning classes.
- Chaps are not required to show in any Beginning classes. Appropriate attire is required for the class being entered.
- Horses need not to be a registered Paint Horse to show in the Beginning class. Exhibitor does not need to own the horse. Rider/exhibitor may cross-enter into other APHA classes at the show, but must meet all ownership and membership requirements for APHA.
- Beginning Halter is open to mares or geldings of any age to compete in the class.
- Beginner classes are open to youth and amateurs.
- If it is determined that an exhibitor is ineligible for a beginning class, they will be disqualified and any awards will be forfeited.

Awards

Belt Buckles to first place and medallions awarded 2nd – 6th place

Eligibility

- The exhibitor must meet the eligibility criteria set forth to be eligible to compete in the Paint Horse Championship classes.
 - Amateur and Youth exhibitors must be enrolled in the APHA Amateur or Youth Program and meet the ownership/lease requirements as per Rule AM-020 and YP-015 respectively.
- Both the exhibitor and the horse owner/lessee must be current APHA members to be eligible to compete.
- Both exhibitor and horse owner/lessee must be residents of the Zone in which the show is held.
- Horses must be registered with the APHA and shown in their respective Paint Horse Championship breed registry class – Regular Registry or Solid Paint-Bred

Exhibitor Eligibility

- Exhibitor must reside in the Zone in which the show is held per APHA records and be a current member of APHA.
- Halter classes: An exhibitor who has placed in the Top 5 in a halter class at an APHA World Championship Show WITHIN THE LAST TEN (10) YEARS (2009-2018) is NOT eligible to compete in any Paint Horse Championship halter class in any division. In addition, an exhibitor who has won a Paint Horse Championship halter class the previous year is ineligible to compete.
 - Example: Susie placed 5th at the 2015 APHA World Championship Show in Youth Geldings. Susie is NOT eligible to compete in any Paint Horse Championship Open, Amateur or Youth halter classes.
- Performance classes: An exhibitor who has placed in the Top 10 in a performance class at an APHA World Championship Show WITHIN THE LAST TEN (10) YEARS (2009-2018) is NOT eligible to compete in any Paint Horse Championship performance class in any division. In addition, an exhibitor who has won a Paint Horse Championship performance class the previous year is ineligible to compete.
 - Example: John was the Reserve World Champion at the 2014 APHA World Championship Show in Amateur Horsemanship. John is NOT eligible to compete in any Paint Horse Championship performance class.
 - EXCEPTIONS:
 - Amateur/Youth Walk-Trot, Novice Amateur/Novice Youth and Intermediate Exhibitor World Show placings and placings in non-pointed World Show classes such as Sweepstakes, Challenge and Futurities DO NOT impact eligibility in regular division championship classes.
 - Amateur/Youth Walk-Trot World Show placings DO count towards exhibitor eligibility criteria in Amateur/Youth Walk-Trot Paint Horse Championship classes.
 - Novice Amateur/Novice Youth World Show placings DO count towards exhibitor eligibility criteria in Novice Amateur/Novice Youth Paint Horse Championship classes.
