- Show Sponsors – A letter was delivered to Wilco Farm Store requesting their sponsorship for the 2019 show season. We are waiting to hear back from them. There is concern that we will not get the awards in time to have embroidery done. It was decided that we will wait one week and if we haven't heard from them then Lisa will order awards for the spring show.
- Awards – Lisa will order them if we need to. She will also get the embroidery done on everything. Erin is going to order the beginner buckles.
- Erin stated that she has a connection with Elite saddles and will contact them about sponsoring the super horse award.

New Business

- OQHA Dual Show
 - There was good reports from those that went and participated. APHA riding classes had good numbers.
 - The OQHA will likely not have the October show as an approved APHA show due to the NW Championship show being the same weekend. Delany will contact OQHA and find out for sure so that we can update our information for the exhibitors.
- NWCC Report – A By-Law committee was formed with Delany Wurdinger, Lisa Seccomb, Lindsay Bates, and Shannon O'Dell to work on making the change to have any APHA approved show in the PNW eligible for NWCC points. There was bids presented at the meeting for awards. People at OPHC meeting thought that 2018 year-end awards were not great quality and seemed cheap. Food at the banquet was bad and not worth the money. It was also a poorly ran banquet/awards.
